THE RADIOLOGIST'S VIEW



Quantifying Whiplash Injury...Is It Possible?

The ability to demonstrate injury secondary to whiplash-associated disorder (WAD) has been tenuous. The foundational diagnostic findings generally include pain, altered biomechanics and reduced range of motion, among others. While diagnostic imaging studies, including plain film, CT

and MRI can yield positive findings such as fractures, disc herniations, ligament laxity and instability, they may not be sufficient to establish a temporal relationship to an injury. Identification of organic lesions in adjacent soft tissues, such as inflammation, are not appreciated. In a recent study, published in the journal PAIN¹, localization and quantification of such lesions was shown to be possible.

Positron emission tomography (PET) is a nuclear medicine imaging technique that uses a radiotracer linked to a radioactive material. They are designed to bind to specific molecules and, depending on the type used, they will concentrate in certain areas of the body or in abnormal tissue such as malignancy or inflammation. The chief advantage of PET is its ability to evaluate function or metabolism, a characteristic not directly available with CT or MRI. The PET scan is often "fused" with CT images for more specific anatomical information.

In the study, the researchers used [11C]-D-deprenyl PET combined with CT for its ability to discriminate between low and high grades of inflammation. In this longitudinal observational study, sixteen adult patients with grade II whiplash injury (defined in the article as neck complaints and decreased range of motion, point tenderness or both) were evaluated within seven days after injury and at six months. Eight control patients were included and were healthy, pain-free and reported no current or previous neck pain. The patients were evaluated for location of tenderness and rated on a Numeric Pain Rating Scale (NRS). Range of motion was assessed, and patients completed a whiplash questionnaire and the Neck Disability Index (NDI) questionnaire. After the PET/CT, the anatomic location of the increased uptake was recorded and compared to the reported tender points.

The authors provided several salient points observed in their study and through associated references:

- 1. Inflammation and tissue injury after WAD can be visualized, quantified, and followed over time.
- 2. There is "...an association between imaging findings in the upper cervical bone structures and patient self-report of pain and disability."
- 3. Evidence of healing was continuing at 6-month follow-up.

- 4. Increased uptake was mostly seen in vertebral bodies, facet joints and surrounding soft tissues "There is growing evidence that facet joints and capsules can be injured in whiplash and that these can be the source of pain." Increased uptake in the region of the occipital condyles and extensor muscles was often seen. Three patients had increased tracer uptake in the TMJ adding cre dence to the idea that there is direct trauma to the joint and that whiplash may be an "...aggravating factor for the progression of temporomandibular joint disorders."
- 5. The number of areas demonstrating increased [¹¹C]-D-deprenyl uptake was associated with NRS and NDI. "This supports the notion that [¹¹C]-Ddeprenyl uptake is related to the extent and severity of the injury."
- 6. "The upper facet joints and vertebral bodies show the strongest association between pain and [¹¹C]-D-deprenyl uptake."
- Increased update in new areas, at six weeks, may indicate ligamentous insufficiency and poor position sense (proprioception). New uptake "... could be the first signs of adaptive or degenerative changes in neck tissues."

The authors addressed the weaknesses and limitations of the study. This included the small sample size and the limited understanding of the exact uptake mechanism of [¹¹C]-D-deprenyl in musculoskeletal injury. The "high costs of PET and feasibility concerns" was an issue. A better control group that may have had a similar injury mechanism but without pain, would be better suited. More study is needed to evaluate predictive and diagnostic value of PET/CT in WAD.

It should not be inferred from this research that PET/CT has now become the latest diagnostic tool to evaluate the WAD patient or that a new weapon has been developed to be utilized in the legal arena to support a diagnosis or prognosis. This study does not support such use and it should not be prescribed until other supportive research becomes available. In any case, it is an extremely costly exam and is likely not readily available or reimbursable by any government or private payor. Caution must be taken in the interpretation of the research findings and any extrapolation of the study's findings to the general population is not recommended. However, the results are promising.






